



Local-level Youth Risk Behavioral Surveillance (YRBS) System Report Module User's Guide

YRBS Overview

The Youth Risk Behavior Surveillance System (YRBSS) includes survey data from multiple national surveys which monitor health behavior indicators among youth and young adults. These indicators include information on behaviors resulting in unintentional injuries and violence, sexual behaviors which contribute to unintended pregnancy and sexually transmitted diseases, alcohol and other drug use, tobacco use, dietary behaviors and physical activity. YRBSS also measures the prevalence of obesity and asthma among this population.

YRBSS specifically includes a national school-based survey, the Youth Risk Behavior Survey or YRBS, conducted by CDC and state, territorial, tribal, and local surveys conducted by state, territorial, and local education and health agencies and tribal governments (<http://www.cdc.gov/HealthyYouth/yrbs/index.htm>).

Currently, users can only generate single reports in the YRBS module.

Step 1. Select Year of data. Users can generate reports for selected year only and not combined years.
