Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS) Report Module User's Guide

BRFSS Overview

The Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS) is a random-digit-dial telephone survey of noninstitutionalized people aged 18 or older. Telephone numbers are selected at random. Once a household is reached, an adult within a household is randomly selected for the interview.

The BRFSS is funded and coordinated nationally by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, Behavioral Surveillance Branch. More information about the BRFSS nationally is available at <u>www.cdc.gov/brfss</u>. Each state has a BRFSS coordinator. In New Hampshire, the BRFSS is housed in the Health Statistics Section of the NH Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health Services. When possible, the most recent data were used. Questions for some indicators are not asked every year that the survey is conducted. As a result, some indicators are from data collected in earlier years.

NH HealthWRQS BRFSS Module Step-by-Step Instructions

There is currently one type of report that can be generated using the BRFSS Module, single reports. Single reports generate outputs based on a single topic category and survey question. Instructions for single reports are detailed below.

General Notes

Respondents who answered "Don't know/Not sure" or "Refused" were typically excluded from analysis, unless otherwise noted.

Please note that the totals of the COLUMNS equal 100%. Interpret the tables accordingly. For example, 74.6% of married people who are self-employed had physical activity or exercise in the past 30 days.

As noted by an asterisk (*) on each of the BRFSS reports, if the denominator sample size is less than 100, the estimate is suppressed, and not displayed in the report. Similarly, as noted by a caretin symbol (^) the estimate is suppressed if the width of the confidence interval exceeds 20 percentage points.
